History

Our first visit to the Alps was in 1997 for a mountain biking holiday in Les Gets, then an upcoming destination on the UCI Mountain Bike World Cup, now a keystone of bike parks in Europe.

Over the next ten years, we visited the Alps for a couple of weeks in the summer for mountain biking and a couple in the winter for snowboarding. Often visiting the Portes du Soleil in summer for its burgeoning mountain bike scene we travelled further afield for snowboarding taking in French and Swiss resorts.

We spent the summer of 1999 in Les Gets and in 2001 visited all the European rounds of the UCI Mountain Bike Downhill World Cup while running a mountain biking website.

In 2007 we moved from the Portes du Soleil to Chamonix Mont-Blanc, spending 2008 there and the summers of 2010, 2011 and 2012. The next few years were spent visiting Switzerland and Austria until 2016 when we spent the year in Chamonix. This year was the basis for our first published magazine which came out in 2018.

Since 2018 we have produced a book or magazine every year.

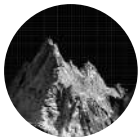
